As part of the design, development and implementation of the MuEuCAP project, he received ongoing input, advice, and shared experiences from Dr Chutamas Satasook, the Vice-President of the Prince of Songkla University (PSU).

As with all Thai universities, PSU has undertaken significant academic reform in the past two decades. It currently has Memoranda of Understanding with the universities of Mandalay and Myeik in Myanmar and until recently was participating in Myanmar-Thai training programmes in biodiversity conservation as well as the supervision of Myanmar PhD students in Thailand.
